Dr. David Dzurec is the Interim Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences and Professor of History at The University of Scranton. Dr. Dzurec received his Ph.D from The Ohio State University in 2008. He earned his MA in History at the University of Connecticut and received his BA in History from Fairfield University. He has been a faculty member at the University since 2008. Dr. Dzurec's research and teaching interests focus on the early United States, American Foreign Relations, and the history of the Jesuits in the United States. He has published articles in *The Historian*, *War in History*, *The Journal of New York History*, *Catholic Historical Review*, and *The Journal of the Early Republic*. His book *Our Suffering Brethren: Foreign Captivity and Nationalism in the Early United States* is available from the University of Massachusetts Press. In 2015 he served as a Fulbright Core Scholar teaching American History and Politics at Trnava University in Slovakia.
