Over the last 17 years in her role as the Emory Palliative Care Center Director, she has made a lasting impact locally, nationally, and internationally as a pioneer in the integration of palliative care in the emergency setting and program building. In 2018, she served as president of the American Academy of Hospice and Palliative Medicine and led a number of key initiatives for AAHPM to success diversity, equity and inclusion for all members.
