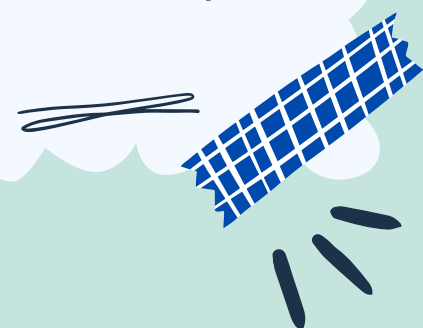

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The goal of the Children's Webb is to maintain basic academic skills and to promote effective social skills through small group activities. In recognition of special needs of youngsters attending the program, a 4 to 1 child to staff ratio is maintained. In addition, therapeutic and medical services are provided. Daily instruction and programming encourage consistency and maintenance of academic skills.

ACTIVITIES

Activities include, but are not limited to academic enrichment, swimming, arts, and crafts, field trips, sports, and leisure games. Staff is a blend of certified special educators and counselors who have demonstrated success in working with children, as well as, proficiency in one or more of the activities offered. A clinician will provide social skills group experiences for children and serve as a program consultant.
